

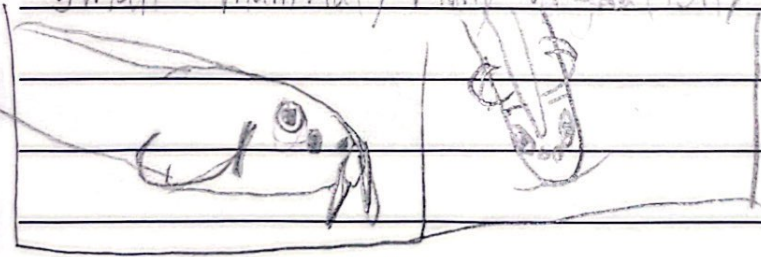

Piefenbaker Pond - 22°C, Overcast

Humidity = 82%

Wind = 11 km/h from WSW

- Pond surrounded by reeds, tall grass, and small trees (pine and others).
- Flat ground at the bottom of a small hill
- Late summer
- City park - Fountain and dock built in.
- Observed in/around: Ducks, insects (Mantises, other), small mammal, many ~~mid~~ fish, smaller blackbird



- Ducks appear to be shedding feathers on south-east side of pond
- Observed in/around: Type of floating plant (green/brown algae?), various trees
- Piles of uncompacted dirt found on ENE side (mole?), on the side of the hill and small forest.
- Park shown to be a gravel pit during 1950s
- At least 11 types of trees found

- Uncompacted dirt also found on west side of pond, where unidentified mammal was spotted. This side of the pond faces open grass, and is next to very dense reeds.



- Tall grass trampled on NW side, near where mammal was seen, uncompacted dirt found in trampled grass.
